JSP 'Spirit filled Church'. TEAM BUILDING: Week Eight – 'Powerful Prayer'

When Peter and John are released from prison, after being arrested for proclaiming the good news about Jesus, the Jerusalem church is vibrant in its praise, and dynamic in praying for boldness and power to heal. So powerful was this prayer that the 'room was shaken' and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. This commitment to prayer and praise strongly reveals that the early church was immensely Jesus-Shaped in a prayer priority that was such a feature of Jesus life and ministry. If we are to continue to grow as a 'Jesus Shaped People' then prayer and praise will be immensely important in growing our relationship with God and ensuring that we stay well focused on his work today. Our capacity to see God's hand at work in contemporary events needs to drive our prayers and our praise. We need to ask some questions of ourselves:

- How do we see God's hand at work in the life of our church?
- How might our church become more vibrant in praise for God's provision?
- How might we re-shape our church worship to include praise that responds to God's presence?
- What can we learn from the intercessory prayer of the disciples to be empowered for mission?
- What opportunities currently exist in church for corporate prayer – are they enough?
- What memories should we be retaining and celebrating of our 'God encounters
